C I R C U L A R

The Emergency Action Committee under the National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme (NVBDCP) of South Goa in its meeting has observed that there are various sites which are hazardous to the residents in the localities which require urgent attention and which may ultimately lead to calamities pertaining to health. The health authorities have identified such sites as dangerous and has requested the local bodies to co-operate with the health authorities and ensure that no licenses are given for any activities to be carried out on these sites which have been identified as dangerous. The details of such dangerous sites may be obtained from the Health authorities.

Further, it is also been observed that many tenants are occupying rental premises where no sanitary facilities are provided by the house owners thereby creating nuisance in the open places and in public property. As such, all the Village Panchayats are hereby directed to ensure that no owner of a house is permitted to rent his house unless proper sanitation is provided therein.

All the Village Panchayats are directed to ensure that the above directions are strictly adhered to and necessary co-operation is extended to the health authorities to prevent any possible health hazard in the localities.
