The Village Panchayat Secretaries of every Village Panchayats are empowered to impose fine on violators who are found using single use plastic this will be vigorously implemented. Panchayats will be motivated and persuaded to developed their own websites and information pertaining to construction license, Occupancy Certificate, Trade license, House Tax payment etc will be hoisted on the websites of the Panchayats. All the Village Panchayats are having data connectivity and the e-services of Birth and Death Certificate will be successfully achieved by 2021. Village Panchayats will be provided Technical Administrative and Financial support in identifying land for construction of Material Recovery Facility (MRF), actual construction of Material Recovery Facility sheds, 100% Collection, Segregation and disposal of wet, dry and plastic waste in all the 191 Panchayats. Providing individual Household Toilets in all the 20024 households. Under the Deen Dayal Scheme funds will be utilized for the purpose of construction of Mega projects such as Community Halls, Market Complex, Panchayat Ghar, etc. In order to ensure Zero discharge of sewage water, violators will be subjected to disconnection of water connection in case found faulty. Public Financial Management System (PFMS) is being put in place whereby funds will be transferred directly in the Panchayat Bank Account and payments to contractors will be strictly done through Bank transfer.
